I am writing to you as I am aware of the Development Application that is being provided by Matthew Klement to the Council.

I want to express the HRSPCA's support of this application in its entirety due to the following reasons;

The Halifax Animal Refuge has been operating since 1991 and has provided a service of re homing dogs that would otherwise be destroyed in our community. The Refuge has ceased operating from its premises since February 2011 due to the ongoing flooding issues at Halifax. There is a definite and known community need for another alternative to continue to provide the much needed community service.
